

THE Plan for forming the Society of the
CINCINATI, together with the
Emblems of the Order, and the several Reso-
lutions passed relative thereto; having been
transmitted to me by his Excellency the Presi-
dent of the Society; with directions to take
the proper steps for establishing a STATE
SOCIETY, in New-Hampshire.—

In obedience to the Instructions received,
I take the liberty of requesting all Officers,
who have served three years as such, in the
New-Hampshire-Line; and others residing
in this State, who have served as Officers in
the American Army three years in the present
war; as well those who have been deranged,
or resigned with honor, as those who are in
actual service, to meet me at the house of
Col. Samuel Folsom, in Exeter, on Tuesday the
18th day of November next, at ten of the
clock in the forenoon, to chuse a State Presi-
dent, and other proper officers of the Society;
and to agree upon the necessary measures for
complying with the regulations established by
the Society at their general meetings.
